How does this reading shape your understanding of what it means to be created in the image and likeness of God?

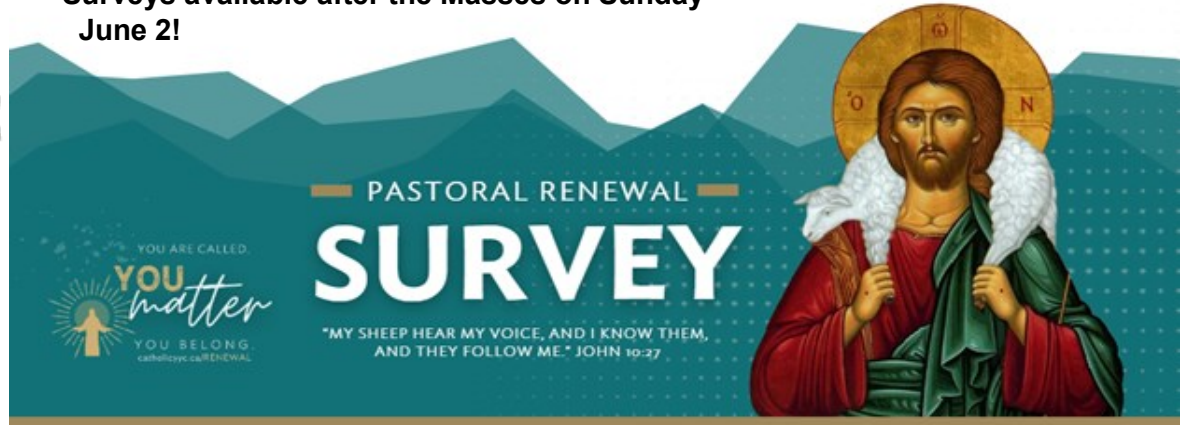
In what areas of your life can you better live and proclaim the love of the Trinity?

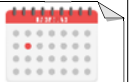

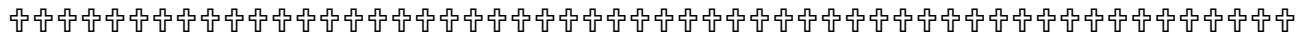

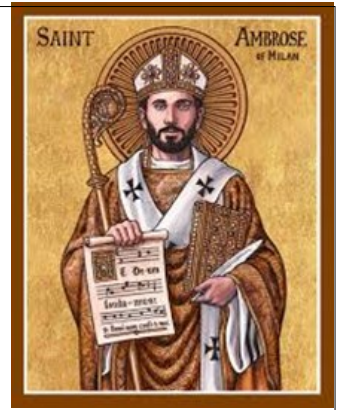
